POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. Only current members of SWFPS may submit paintings to the show.
2. A maximum of two (2) entries per member may be submitted. All that meet guidelines will be exhibited.
3. Submission fees are \$15 for one painting and \$10 for the next. Payment of fee by cash or check made payable to SWFPS. Fees are not refundable.
4. All artworks must have been completed within the past two years. Works must be original not a copy of another artist's work or copied from a magazine, book, digital image or photograph not taken by the artist or used without written permission.
6. Artworks shown in previous SWFPS shows may **NOT** be exhibited in this show.
6. Show will be judged for awards.
7. The SWFPS and Marco Island Center for the Arts reserve the right to decline art works deemed inappropriate for display.
8. Artworks must be picked up at the designated time or special arrangements made.
10. SWFPS and the host gallery occasionally photograph participants and/or their artwork for use in newsletters and publicity. Photos taken by SWFPS or the host gallery become property of the organization and may be used in promotional materials now and in the future.
11. There will be no separation of Artist and Student works. However we trust that if a work was done with extensive hands-on by the instructor, you will not submit it.
12. Commission is 25% to Marco Island Center for the Arts.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ART WORK

MAXIMUM FRAMED SIZES

1 large of 152" maximum circumference (ex. 36x40) **OR** 2 smaller of 128" maximum circumference.

2. Art must be suitably framed and wired with wire ends taped. Wire, when pulled, must be **at least** three (3) inches down from the center of the top of the frame. Fasteners, such as screw eyes that hold wire, must be totally secure. Saw tooth hangers are not permitted. Frames, mats, glass, or Plexiglass must be clean and not scratched or marred.

3. Art work not properly prepared for showing may be declined.
